Day 1: Wednesday, September 22, 2027 Overnight Flight Discover spectacular Switzerland, Austria and Bavaria on a tour featuring Munich's legendary Oktoberfest.

Day 2: Thursday, September 23, 2027 Bern, Switzerland Arrive in Bern, Switzerland's charming capital and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. With its cobblestone streets and medieval architecture, Bern feels beautifully preserved in time. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner featuring local cuisine. (D)

Day 3: Friday, September 24, 2027 Bern - Habkern - Bern Travel to Habkern, a postcard-perfect mountain village near Interlaken. Visit a local workshop to learn how the alphorn is crafted and enjoy a yodeling demonstration led by a professional performer. Cap off the experience with a fondue lunch at a local restaurant before returning to Bern for a leisurely afternoon. (B, L)

Day 4: Saturday, September 25, 2027 Bern Enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of Bern with a local guide. Highlights include the Bundeshaus (the Swiss Parliament), the famous Bear Pit, the Rose Gardens, and the soaring Gothic cathedral that crowns Old Town's skyline. The afternoon is free to explore independently. Perhaps you'll take a ride on the Gurtenbahn funicular, climbing Gurten Mountain to an altitude of 2,574 feet (858 meters) for sweeping views of the city and surrounding countryside. (B)

Day 5: Sunday, September 26, 2027 Bern - Lucerne - Bern Set out for Lucerne, often called the "Swiss Paradise on the Lake." Join a guided walking tour of Altstadt, featuring the covered Chapel Bridge, the famous Water Tower, the Renaissance-style Town Hall, and the Lion Monument, carved from natural rock to commemorate the heroic Swiss Guard. Enjoy your free time exploring this magnificent city, or perhaps join an optional tour to the legendary Mount Pilatus. Return to Bern this evening for dinner at one of the city's renowned restaurants. (B, D)

Day 6: Monday, September 27, 2027 Bern - Vaduz, Liechtenstein - Innsbruck, Austria En route to Innsbruck, make your way through Liechtenstein, the world's smallest German-speaking country and the only European country to lie entirely within the Alps. Spend some time in Vaduz, strolling through the charming old quarter and along the pedestrian-friendly *Stadtle*, referred to as "small town" by the locals. Upon arrival in Innsbruck, **it's your choice!** Join a guided walk highlighting Innsbruck's history and landmarks, including Maria-Theresien-Strasse, the Hofburg, and the "Golden Roof" **-OR-** you may embark on a tour to the Nordkette, Innsbruck's stunning mountain range, where you'll enjoy breathtaking alpine views and experience the dramatic scenery that rises directly from the heart of the city. (B)

Day 7: Tuesday, September 28, 2027 Innsbruck - Salzburg - Innsbruck Travel through scenic countryside

to Salzburg. Discover the city on a walking tour featuring Mirabell Gardens, the quaint Getreidegasse (Mozart's birthplace), and other highlights of this Baroque jewel. Enjoy lunch at a legendary 1,200-year-old St. Peter's Restaurant, the oldest in Austria and still owned by the monks. Enjoy time in the afternoon at leisure before returning to Innsbruck. (B, L)

Day 8: Wednesday, September 29, 2027 Innsbruck - Bavaria, Germany - Innsbruck Cross into Bavaria to tour Linderhof Palace, the only palace — out of three — that King Ludwig II lived to see completed. With an expert guide, explore its lavish interiors inspired by Versailles. Continue to Ettal Abbey* — a Benedictine monastery founded in 1330, where you'll tour the Basilica and enjoy a brewery visit with tastings. Return

to Innsbruck and delight in a Tyrolean folklore show hosted by a well-known local musical family.** (B)

Day 9: Thursday, September 30, 2027 Innsbruck - Munich, Germany Travel to Munich to experience Oktoberfest, the world-famous folk festival dating back to the 1800s. Today, the celebration draws visitors from around the globe and features lively music, traditional costumes, savory Bavarian cuisine, amusement rides, and millions of liters of beer. In your reserved tent, raise a toast to a fun-filled day of drinks, games, and time spent with friendly locals. (B, L)

Day 10: Friday, October 1, 2027 Munich - Tour Ends Your tour comes to an end in Munich. (B)

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Linderhof Palace touring includes standing, stairs, and walking through large grounds. Abbey and brewery visit includes uneven flooring.

Coach drop-off occurs outside of the Oktoberfest festival grounds, walking is required. Expect security check points, standing and slow-moving foot traffic.

Salzburg's Old Town does not allow coaches to access the center. You should anticipate walking at least 0.5 miles to reach the Old Town for the start of your day's touring and lunch.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Oktoberfest takes place in mid-September and early October, when the weather in Munich can be unpredictable. Days may be mild and sunny, but evenings are often cool with possible rain.

Nordkette Alpine Experience (Choice on Tour) is an ascend from Innsbruck to nearly 6300 feet/1920 meters above sea level for Alpine views. The experience takes approximately 2 to 3 hours.

Linderhof Palace is located at an altitude of approximately 3280 feet/1000 meters above sea level.

The day you visit Salzburg will be one of the longest days of this tour as it takes about 3 hours each way to get there from Innsbruck.

*Ettal Abbey may be closed to tours on some departures. When closed, travelers will have an alternate inclusion.

Visits to Ettal Abbey and Linderhof Palace may occur in a different order than indicated in the published itinerary due to operational considerations, local scheduling, or public holidays. In some cases, alternative arrangements may be necessary; however, all included sightseeing will be provided whenever possible.

**The Tyrolean folklore show may be scheduled on a different evening than the one indicated in the itinerary while in Innsbruck.

Oktoberfest is a lively Bavarian celebration with communal settings, and a festive atmosphere. Festival tents can be crowded and noisy, which is a part of the authentic experience.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our transfers will depart from Zurich, Switzerland airport and return to Munich, Germany airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Our air travelers will arrive into Zurich, Switzerland airport and depart from Munich, Germany airport.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Due to tour scheduling, flights must arrive into Zurich prior to 4:00 p.m.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:
